

Memorandum of Association For A Non-Profit Society

The name of the Society is the Association of Bayside Camp and Retreat Center (the "Society").

The activities of the Society shall be carried out in the Province of Nova Scotia.

The registered office of the Society shall be located at 1503 Ketch Harbour Road, Sambro Head, Nova Scotia, B3V 1L3.

The objects of the Society are:

1. To advance religion by operating, maintaining and promoting a Christian Camp and Retreat Center for the benefit of the member churches of the Halifax Region United Baptist Association, member churches of other Associations within the Convention of Atlantic Baptist Churches and other Evangelical Churches and persons.
2. To do all such things as may be directly or indirectly incidental, conducive, convenient, or proper for the accomplishment of the purposes or the attainment of the objects of the Society.
3. To acquire by way of grant, gift, purchase, bequest, devise or otherwise, real and personal property and to use and apply such property to the realization of the objects of the Society;
4. To buy, own, hold, lease, mortgage, sell and convey such real and personal property as may be necessary or desirable in the carrying out of the objects of the Society

PROVIDED that nothing herein contained shall permit the Society to carry on any trade, industry, or business and the Society shall be carried on without purpose or gain to any of the members and that any surplus or any accretions of the Society shall be used solely for the purposes of the Society and promotion of its objects.

PROVIDED, further, that if for any reason the operations of the Society are terminated or are wound up, or are dissolved and there remains, at that time, after satisfaction of all its debts and liabilities, any property whatsoever, the same shall be distributed to one or more qualified donees within the meaning of subsection 248(1) of the Income Tax Act. As long as it continues to be a qualified donee within the meaning of subsection 248(1) of the Income Tax Act, the remaining property shall be distributed in its entirety to the Halifax Region United Baptist Association.

WE, the several persons whose names, addresses and occupations are subscribed, desire to be formed into a society in pursuance of this Memorandum of Association.
